Exhibit Terms and Conditions

1. Application for Sponsorship/Exhibit Space

This contract/application must be accompanied by a check or credit card for full payment.

2. Sponsor/Exhibit Eligibility

Product brochures for medical devices and/or drugs which are subject to approval by the United States Food and Drug Administration or other government agency and which are to be exhibited at the GNYC SNMMI-TS meeting must be approved by FDA or the appropriate agencies or authorities of the federal, state, or local government. All products and services to be exhibited must be directly related to the practice of nuclear medicine and medicine in general and are subject to review by the GNYC SNMMI-TS. Exhibitors may display only those products and services that they regularly manufacture or distribute. Applications deemed ineligible will be returned with exhibit space payment.

3. Sponsor's Representatives

The application signatory or his designee shall be the official representative of the exhibitor, certify representatives and act on behalf of the exhibitor in all negotiations.

4. Acceptance of Exhibit Space Applications

Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. GNYC SNMMI-TS will assign all space and reserves the right to rearrange the floor plan at any time. GNYC SNMMI-TS reserves the right to relocate exhibitors should it become necessary for causes beyond the control of GNYC SNMMI-TS or advisable in the best judgment of GNYC SNMMI-TS.

6. Exhibit Payment Schedule

Application must be accompanied by full payment in U.S. funds. Checks should be payable to "Greater New York Tech Section - SNMMI".

7. Cancellation/Refund of Exhibit Space Fees

Written notification of cancellation must be received by GNYC SNMMI-TS on or before the dates specified. If sponsorship is canceled on or before March 17, 2023, a refund less a 20% cancellation fee will be issued. If sponsorship is canceled after March 17, 2023, the sponsor shall remain liable to GNYC SNMMI-TS for the total sponsorship fee. Exhibit Space not claimed and occupied prior to 7:00 am, Friday, April 28, 2023, for which no special arrangements have been made with GNYC SNMMI-TS, may be resold or reassigned by GNYC SNMMI-TS without obligation on the part of GNYC SNMMI-TS to refund sponsorship fees, and without obligation to assign the sponsor to other space.

8. Subletting of Space

Sponsors may not assign, sublet or apportion to others the whole or any part of the space allocated and may not display goods or services other than those manufactured or regularly distributed by them or their subsidiaries.

9. Insurance & Liability

The sponsor shall be fully responsible for any claims, liabilities, losses, damages or expenses relating to or arising from an inquiry to any person, or any loss of or damage to property where such inquiry, loss or damage is incident to, arises out of, or is in any way connected with sponsor's participation in the exhibition (except as otherwise provided in the agreement between GNYC SNMMI-TS and the Kalahari Resorts & Conventions, Pocono Manor, PA.
